This qualification reflects the role of individuals who have a dream to work as beauty therapists to provide a range of beauty therapy treatments and services, including lash and brow treatments, nail services, make-up, massage and waxing.

They communicate with clients to recommend treatments and services and sell retail skin care and cosmetic products.

The goal within this qualification is to ensure these individuals undertake work independently, with limited guidance from others, to perform routine and non-routine activities and solve non-routine problems. They apply and adapt technical skills and knowledge, and use judgment in the provision of beauty treatments and services. These individuals are responsible for their own outputs and provide limited guidance to others.

Work is typically conducted but not limited to beauty salons, spas and Cruise liners.

# REFUNDPOLICY

Australasia International School(AIS) will refund:

- If the Australian Government has refused to grant a visa:
   a)If the Australian government refuses a student visa, the refund amount will be tuition fees in full.
   b)The refund will be made within 28 days (or 4 weeks) of receiving a student's written claim and certified evidence of the Department of Home Affairs (DHA) rejection of the visa application.
- 2. If AIS is unable to offer the course or the course is cancelled, then AIS will refund all course money in accordance with the provisions of sections 27 and 29 of the Education Services for Overseas Students Act 2000.
- 3. If the application for a refund is received more than 28 days (or 4 weeks) before the enrolment date of the course: a) 80% of the total course fee will be refunded. b) The refund will be made once the payment is cleared and within 28 days (or 4 weeks) of receiving a student's written claim.
- 4. If the application for a refund is received less than 28 days (or 4 weeks) before the enrolment date of the course: a)50% of the total course fee will be refunded.
  b)The refund will be made once the payment is cleared and within 28 days (or 4 weeks) of receiving a student's written claim.
- 5. No refund will be granted once the enrolment period has commenced in relation to points 3 and 4 above.
