The Diploma of Salon Management qualification reflects the role of senior managers and small business owners of personal services businesses.

They are responsible for coordinating the day-to-day operation of the business and for planning, monitoring and evaluating the work of the team.

Salon managers also operate with significant autonomy to make strategic business management decisions.

This qualification provides a pathway to work as a salon manager in any type of personal service business including hairdressing or beauty salons, barber shops and spas.

REFUNDPOLICY

Australasia International School(AIS) will refund:

- If the Australian Government has refused to grant a visa:
 a)If the Australian government refuses a student visa, the refund amount will be tuition fees in full.

- 2. If AIS is unable to offer the course or the course is cancelled, then AIS will refund all course money in accordance with the provisions of sections 27 and 29 of the Education Services for Overseas Students Act 2000.

- 4. If the application for a refund is received less than 28 days (or 4 weeks) before the enrolment date of the course: a)50% of the total course fee will be refunded.
 b)The refund will be made once the payment is cleared and within 28 days (or 4 weeks) of receiving a student's written claim.
- 5. No refund will be granted once the enrolment period has commenced in relation to points 3 and 4 above.
- 6. There will be no refund on enrolment fee, accommodation arrangement fee and airport pickup service fee.
